Construction Summary Worksheet

Use this worksheet if you built a new house or substantially renovated your existing house, and you are filing Form GST191, GST/HST New Housing Rebate Application for Owner-Built Houses to claim a GST/HST new housing rebate.

If you are making a claim for a substantial renovation or a major addition, make sure you meet the conditions. For more information and for instructions on how to fill out this form. see Guide RC4028, GST/HST New Housing Rebate.

All rebate claims are subject to audit. To avoid delaying your claim or having this claim denied, make sure this worksheet is filled out in full. You must enter all the information requested on this worksheet, since we use it to verify your eligibility for the rebate. You can apply for the new housing rebate only once for each house, using one application form and worksheet for each house.

Attach this form to Form GST191 and keep a copy for your records. Send us your invoices (we accept photocopies) with your forms only if the vendor did not charge the GST/HST on the invoice. However, you must keep your proof of occupancy and the original invoices for at least six years in case we ask to see them.

Generally, to claim the rebate, you have two years from the date the construction or substantial renovation is substantially completed (you can reasonably inhabit the premises). For more information, see Guide RC4028, GST/HST New Housing Rebate, go to canada.ca/gst-hst, or call 1-800-959-5525.

Part C – Construction details

In the following chart, for each vendor, list the total of all the construction invoices for these qualifying goods and services, whether or not the vendor charged the GST/HST. If a vendor did not charge you the GST/HST, attach a copy of the invoice to the worksheet. We accept photocopies. Only invoices in the **name of the claimant or co-owners' names** qualify for the rebate. You may record all the invoices from the same vendor on one line (use the date of the earliest invoice in the "Invoice date" column). Keep all your invoices for **at least** six years in case we ask to see them.

Enter the vendor's name, business number (GST/HST number), and the GST/HST paid. Do not include estimates or quotes. **Use pages 4, 5, 6, and 7 to record the GST paid. Use pages 8, 9, 10, and 11 to record the HST paid**. Follow the instructions on page 12, and enter the amounts onto page 3 of Form GST191, GST/HST New Housing Rebate Application for Owner-Built Houses. Photocopy and attach more worksheets if needed. You can use an exact copy (for example, a computer-generated printout) of the following chart . However, make sure it follows the same format as the one below.

Non-qualifying items: Certain items do not qualify for the new housing rebate. For example, you cannot claim for the purchase or installation of any of the following:

• free-standing appliances or furniture

• pesticides, weed spraying

a television, DVD player, or sound system

electricity and heating bills, moving expenses

- power tools used to build the house
- any kind of draperies or blinds

- area rugs, linens
- artwork or home furnishings that are not fixtures
